H.O.P.E. Training Courses

Course B. NBCUSA Certified Health Ministry Ambassador® (CHMA) - Pastor Dexter G. Moragne, Instructor, Cobo Center Room 430B. This course is open to those just beginning in congregational health ministry. Topics covered include: Why?, What?, and How? of starting a congregational health ministry.

Course C. Certified Health Ministry Promoter (CHMP) – Minister Stacey Bottoms, Instructor, Cobo Center Room 430B. This course is open to students who have completed Course B NBCUSA Certified Health Ministry Ambassador training or with special permission of the H.O.P.E. Training Institute Director. Topics covered include: What Is Health Promotion?, How Do You Identify Partners and Resources from Various Community Sectors?, and How Do You Become a Community Resource. *Note: Course completers will also be certified through the H.O.P.E. Health Initiative to teach the NBCUSA CHMA training courses at the state and local levels.*

Course D. Congregational Health Leader – Pastor Bernard Montgomery, Instructor, Cobo Center Room 430B. This course is open to students who have completed Course C NBCUSA Certified Health Ministry Promoter training or with special permission of the H.O.P.E. Training Institute Director. Topics covered include: How Do You Use Prayer as an Intervention?, How Do We Engage in Advocacy?, and How Do We Utilize Self-Care and Health and Wellness Coaching? *Note: Course completers will also be certified through the H.O.P.E. Health Initiative to teach the NBCUSA CHMA and CHMP training classes at the state and local levels.*
